English Language and Literature

General Information:

- The exam in LINGUISTICS will be a paper-based exam in a regular classroom. The exam in LITERATURE will be delivered digitally through the Moodle platform using shared university computers.
- Choose a seat where you cannot be suspected of glancing at another student's paper or exposing your paper to any other student. Doing either of these things could lead to your immediate expulsion from the examination room and disciplinary action.
- Once seated, **please do not leave your seat** unless absolutely necessary. If you do need to leave temporarily, please inform a member of staff immediately.
- Please ensure that all mobile phones, and electronic devices are switched off. The use of a cell phone or a digital watch is not permitted during the exam.
- The use of reference materials during the exam is not permitted.
- On your exam desk or computer station have only a pen and a bottle of water in addition to the exam paper.
- For the linguistic part **Identify yourself on the exam paper** in ink with your name, student number, and signature.
- For the literary part, **you must have your username and password** to login into Moodle. If you do not know your user and password you will not be able to take the exam.
- When leaving the room after the digital part of the exam you will be asked to sign your name and the time of exit from the class.
- The examination room **closes five minutes prior** to the start of each of the four parts. After that you will not be allowed to enter. It is your responsibility to ensure that you arrive in good time to sitthe exam.

Exam Format:
